Quick Facts:

- 32% of young Jordanians (15-30 years old) are unemployed, against a world average of 15%—one of the highest unemployment rates among youth in the world!
- 60% of the population in Jordan age 15+ is not economically active (35% of males and 85% of females >15 years are not economically active)
- 70% of Jordanian youth who are one year out of school are still unemployed (youth unemployment is mostly concentrated among the educated). Youth aged 15-29 comprise 73% of the unemployed
